CompE	Math 150 & 151, Phys 195 & 196, CompE 160 and EE 210
ConE	Math 150 & 151, Chem 202 or 200, Phys 195 & 196, and CivE 225
ConMgt	Math 150, Phys 180a & 180b, Chem 100, and CivE 225
EE	Math 150 & 151, Phys 195 & 196, CompE 160 and EE 210
ME	Math 150 & 151, Chem 202 or 200, Phys 195 & 196, and ME 200 or AE 200

*Students usually complete the listed courses by the end of their 3rd or 4th semester

Retention Policy

Engineering premajors who have either: (1) completed major preparatory courses, earned 60 units, but have less than a 2.7 cumulative GPA; or (2) earned 60 units but have not completed major preparatory courses and/or have less than a 2.7 cumulative GPA may be removed from the premajor.
